Key Priorities & Projects

Priorities

- ▶ Tackling Climate Change and Environmental Emergency - enable our local community to meet the Borough's goals, ensuring the climate and environment are central in every project delivered and decision taken.
- ▶ Prosperity - Members will work tirelessly to protect the environment, and ensure any development has regard to the views and well-being of existing residents, communities, wildlife and countryside.
- ▶ Improving Community Wellbeing - Maximise the delivery of community benefits and facilities in partnership with the local parish council's, including the use of developer contributions.

Projects

- ▶ Memorial Hall & Glebe Meadow Project - Develop the feasibility design for the Memorial Hall and submit for planning approval.
- ▶ Y Zone – Ensure smooth transition from internal to new external provider. Work with new provider to deliver a bold, modern, fit for purpose youth provision that targets young people most in need of support.

- ▶ Lapstone Farm Cricket Provision – Set up project team and begin work to provide a second wicket on site for Fair Oak Cricket Club.
- ▶ Quobleigh Woods – Complete the transfer this countryside asset from the developer and work with the Council's Countryside team to bring the site up to standard, utilising the specialist inside knowledge.
- ▶ New Century Park Café & Splash pad – Work in partnership with Fair Oak & Horton Heath Parish Council to deliver this exciting community asset.
- ▶ Asset transfers – complete all existing asset transfers for BIFOHH from the developer to the Council, and then to the appropriate Parish where relevant.
- ▶ The Planney & Tree Corridor Project - Complete the revitalisation of the Planney woodland and the Tree Corridor project, which aims to tackle climate change and increase wildlife habitats.
- ▶ Public Art - Produce a Public Art Strategy for the local area, and deliver public art projects in a joined up approach, that reflect the natural environment and essence of the local villages.
