

QUESTIONS FOR COUNCIL MEETING – 27 NOVEMBER 2023

(1) Question from Councillor Parker-Jones to Councillor House:

How much money did the council spend on design, merchandise, marketing etc. of its company 'leaf' before rebranding to 'Eastbrooke'?

(2) Question from Councillor Tidridge to Councillor House:

Allotments at Brick Kiln Lane, off Bow Lake Gardens, in Bishopstoke are unusable and have been subjected to vandalism and anti-social behaviour incidents. They were to be transferred from the developer to Eastleigh Borough Council and then onto Bishopstoke Parish Council as part of the Bow Lake Gardens development's planning conditions. The development has been completed and houses occupied for over three years, yet the allotments remain unusable. The Local Area Committee for Bishopstoke, Fair Oak and Horton Heath has requested updates from the council frequently, but no plan has been shared showing when the transfer will take place or how the developer is being held to account. Please can the Cabinet member with responsibility for planning please update members with proposed actions and deadlines for delivery?

(3) Question from Councillor Broomfield to Councillor House:

Could the Leader confirm that One Horton Heath has requisitioned all the drainage works that the scheme requires? I am thinking particularly of the sewers running through the Allington Lane/Fair Oak Road junction and subsequently along Fair Oak Road.

(4) Question from Councillor Parker-Jones to Councillor Kyrle:

How many of the 160,000 promised planted trees have been planted to date?

(5) Question from Councillor Parker-Jones to Councillor Craig:

The covid recovery grant was supposed to be open until 1 March 2024 but has already closed. How much has been provided to which organisations?
